

Outreach Services

Dresser Village Library will maintain an Outreach program and will coordinate delivery services of library materials to homebound individuals living within the Village of Dresser. Village residents who are homebound are eligible to receive services. "Homebound" is defined as being confined to one's home due to illness, age, disability, or other qualifying circumstance. Individuals who are not homebound but have no other means of receiving library services may request Outreach Service. Each request for this service will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Because recipients of this services receive and return library materials based upon the Outreach delivery schedule, no overdue fines will be charged. However, participants are responsible for all items checked out on their Outreach library cards and will be charged the standard fee for any lost or damaged item(s).

Delivery and pick up services will be provided by Interfaith Caregivers of Polk County. Outreach patrons will be added, adjusted, or reduced based on patron needs and availability of Interfaith Caregivers.
