***Safety of our patrons and staff is our number one priority. The Public Library is taking precautions to help prevent any exposure or infection but cannot guarantee that the library is virus free. Any one not following established safe policies set forth may be asked to leave the facility.***

***If you or any person in your household is not feeling well, or has been recommended to quarantine, please remain home for the safety of everyone.***

*These specific COVID policy amendments supersede existing library policies.*

- A face covering / non-medical mask is **required** for anyone over the age of 2, unless a medical condition prevents its use.
  - A disposable mask will be provided free of charge to those without one.
  - Curbside Service will continue to be available to anyone who is unable, or unwilling, to wear a face covering.
- Six feet social distancing must be maintained wherever possible with anyone who is not a member of your household.
- Patrons should wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer prior to entering the library, before and after using computers, and after contact with high touch areas.
- Prolonged socializing is not permitted at this time.
- We will operate at a reduced capacity to comply with social distancing requirements. The current capacity limit will be posted near the library door.
- Restrictive tape or barriers of any kind, including protective coverings on public use computer devices, may not be removed to accommodate access.
- Time limits for computer access will be reduced and will be enforced.
- Priority will be given to those using computer access for employment, tax preparation, or educational purposes.
- No more than one individual per computer station. Exception of one additional individual living in the same household.
- Restrooms will be locked but available if needed, by request, to facilitate maintaining a clean environment.
