Director's Report

Leann stated that the Early Riser Book Club meeting scheduled for June 7th was cancelled. The Open Knitting group continues to meet every Tuesday. Littles Storytime continues to be held Mondays at 10:30. No patrons attended storytime in May. Total circulation in May was 887, with 488 visits to the library, 2 new patrons, and 88 new items added to the collection. The village gardeners, Barb and Lee, are working on improving the appearance of the lawn in front of the library building. They are also working with the Lions Club to get a bench to place under the shade tree. The internet router stopped working and was replaced June 13th. Summer Reading programming began May 30th with the Summer Reading Challenge. In-person programs began June 5th. The school-age program had 68 attendees the first Monday, and 56 the next (more statistics will be available at July meeting). Kids Care is bringing children to the library to browse, select, and check out books. Last year this resulted in bringing whole families to the library. All summer reading signage, shirts, incentives, etc. have been procured.
