

Library Renaming Policy

ADOPTED: October 14, 2019

It is the policy of the Dresser Village Library Board, with the support of the Dresser Village Board, to recognize the generosity of individuals by naming (or renaming) facilities or parts of facilities in their honor. The board reserves the right to decline any gift to the library or reject any naming proposal.

“Generosity” is defined as a significant monetary donation or outstanding service to the library or community.

All naming rights shall be approved for 20 years or until a new facility is built at which time naming of facilities will be reviewed by the library board. A plaque may be placed and remain in the location acknowledging the name and donation/outstanding service.

The Library Board reserves the right to terminate or alter a naming designation under unusual circumstances, or if an individual or organization named comes into disrepute at the Library or the community at large.

Upon approval of the naming by the library board, an appropriate dedication ceremony may be planned and conducted. The donor, guests, media, and community will be notified for attendance and participation.

This policy will be reviewed as needed and is subject to change.
